Epistle: 1 Corinthians 1:18-24 A Reading from the Letter of Saint Apostle Paul to Corinthians:

Brothers and Sisters, the message about the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God. For it is written, "I will destroy the wisdom of the wise, and the discernment of the discerning I will thwart." Where is the one who is wise? Where is the scribe? Where is the debater of this age? Has not God made foolish the wisdom of the world?
